**Building Funds for Bible Studies to the Sudanese Children with "the Word of God" to reduce "living in Juvenile prisons" in Omaha, Bellevue, Nebraska for the Year 2009:**

We would like to send this proposal to whom it may concern, Isaac Luk's Christian Hope Ministry Outreach Inc, is a registered 501(c) (3) Non- profit Christian organization, which is incorporated under the laws of the State of Nebraska. The purpose of this organization, is to teach, fellowship, preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ, to the world of despair, and to Give Hope to the Hopeless, through the Healing Word of Jesus Christ, and to witness His Salvation to the world.

The purpose of this proposal, is to quickly response to an outcry of young Sudanese Children, who are living behind bars at juvenile prisons in Omaha, Bellevue, Nebraska, with the Word of God. Many of them, who are serving times in prisons, are lamenting that they are there, because no one had stepped into their lives with the "Word of God." When we hear these heartbreaking words, coming out from the mouths of these young Sudanese children, they are conveying a message that needed an ear to hear, from someone, who can put himself, or herself into their shoes. They are feeling the pains of living at Juvenile prisons. They needed someone to bring about change to their lives, because they are unable to bring change to their own. These situations are facing many young Sudanese children at Juvenile prisons across the country. One out of three children among Sudanese families living in Omaha, and Bellevue, Nebraska, are living in foster cares, and are separated from their parents. Please, it is such a critical time, for **Isaac Luk's Christian Hope Ministry Outreach Inc**, to promptly ask of your financial contributions of any kind, for the future's generation of these young Sudanese survivors of Civil war in Sudan. Please, your financial contribution will help us move these mountains from their shoulders. These funds will be going towards renting a place for Bible Studies, during this cold season. A place where many young Sudanese children will be taught the Word of God.

Many Sudanese Children, who are at risk, have been separated from their homes and parents, by the government. They are becoming rebellions toward their parents. They have end up indulging themselves into crimes, which they were not supposed to commit. One of the major factor facing Young Sudanese Children, is the lack of teaching from the Word of God, which they are missing in their lives. They are living at Juveniles prisons in Omaha, Bellevue, Nebraska, including its surrounding.

It has come to our attention, that many Sudanese boys, and girls are now living their lives in prisons, because they have not get, the right learning from the Word of God, when they were in their home country of Sudan, because of the Civil war. If they could have been taught the Word of God in their country, they could be respectful to their parents. Many of them are growing up without the proper teaching at home, or how to fear God and the Laws. Many young Sudanese children, who were born in Sudan, were separated from learning the Word of God by the Sudan Civil War, which had killed 2.5 million men and women, during its twenty years of war. For this reason, many young Sudanese children, who came to the United States, are lacking an important teaching from the Word of God. They grew up without learning the Word of God in Sudan due to the Civil war. This had been added to the cultural shock of living in the United State, where many children are becoming more rebellions to their parents. Teaching them the Word of God now is the only solution, for them to behave respectfully to their parents, or to obey the laws. Because them running away from their parents, or home is Not a solution. Many young Sudanese children, who ran away from their parents are now living in the government foster cares. And those who rebels against the laws are serving their lives in juveniles prisons.

All these problems had happened to them, because they did not have a chance to learned from the Word of God. When children are faced with sensitive circumstances in their lives, they do not know how to go about with decisions making for themselves. They do not know how to approached these circumstances. If these young Sudanese children, were taught the Word of God, when they were young, they can grow in it. They could not live their lives now at Juveniles prisons across the country. **Isaac Luk's Christian Hope Ministry Outreach Inc**, is determined to do more, and what it will take to bring about change with the Word of God, in the lives of these young Sudanese Children, during the year of 2008-2009.

Many children who are not yet corrupted, still need the hand of Christ in their lives, together with our own commitments, to stepped into their lives with the Word of God. Please, your financial decision to this letter matters the most, for us to bring about change in their lives, by us teaching them the Word of God, which will keep them away from Juvenile prisons. Young Sudanese children who came to the United States, when they were young, did not had a chance to learned the Word of God in their country and from their parents, due to lack of education, and knowledge from the Word of God, even to those children born in the United States.


They do not listened to their parents, because they did not learned the, "Wisdom of God's Word." that says, "children respect your parents that you live longer on earth." Many young Sudanese children are serving their times in prisons. They are sleeping many nights, away from home, because no one had stepped into their lives with the Word of God, which could have saved them from cultural shock and crimes. If they are now taught the Word of God, they will not be committing crimes, which are keeping many teens to continue living behind bars, by not obeying the laws. The Word of God will changed them, at home and at schools. Please, consider this letter to be your whistle blower, concerning the problems, that are facing these young Sudanese children living in Omaha, and Bellevue, Nebraska. Your lack of response to this letter will result into many Sudanese children living their lives in prisons, where their dreams and love from their parents will forever be lost. **Isaac Luk's Christian Hope Ministry Outreach Inc**, its main purpose, is to bring about change to this population by "Giving Hope to the Hopeless." Please, without your contribution, nothing will be done to bring about change to this fragile segment of these young Sudanese children. Please, act now, and your contribution, will make a difference in their lives. Please, we kindly, appreciated your generous support during this critical time of need to rescue these Sudanese Children, living in Omaha, and Bellevue, Nebraska, from pain with the Word of God.
